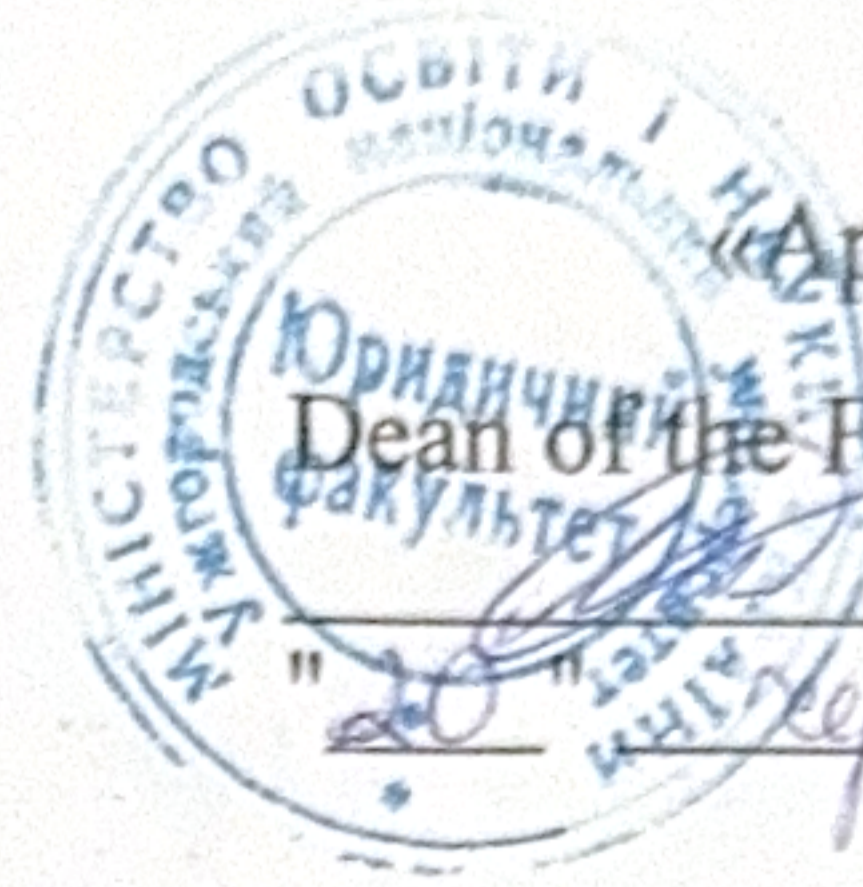





2. THE PURPOSE OF THE ACADEMIC DISCIPLINE

The purpose of the discipline "International Law for the Protection of Human Rights and Fundamental Freedoms" is to study the general patterns of human rights consolidation in international treaties, the protection of human rights in international courts and international organizations, the implementation of decisions adopted by the ECHR and recommendations of international organizations.

Knowledge of the study of the discipline occurs in the formation of theoretical knowledge about human rights in international law, with the foundations of the theory and practice of international human rights law and international protection of human rights at the international level, the functioning of universal regional and mechanisms for the protection of human rights, as well as to teach general competencies, the ability to work with international legal sources, their analysis and interpretation.

According to the educational program, the study of the discipline worsens the formation of the following competencies in higher education applicants:

Integral competence:

The ability to analyze court cases and judicial practice adopted by the ECHR, the interaction of national and international law, to analyze, interpret and apply sources of international and national law.

Modular test work assessment criteria

A grade of excellent (A) is given when a student gives absolutely correct answers to theoretical questions with a statement of original conclusions obtained on the basis of program, additional material and regulatory documents. When performing a practical task, the student applies systemic knowledge of the educational material provided for by the curriculum.

A grade of good (B) is given to a student who has fully disclosed theoretical questions on the basis of program and additional material. When performing practical tasks, the student applies the generalized knowledge of the educational material provided for by the curriculum.

A good (C) grade is given to a student who has fully revealed the theoretical issues, and the program material is presented in accordance with the requirements. Practical tasks are generally performed correctly, but there are some inaccuracies.

A satisfactory (D) grade is given when the student has revealed the theoretical issues, but some errors are made when presenting the program material. When performing practical tasks, the student makes mistakes due to insufficient understanding of the program material.

A satisfactory (E) grade is given when the student has not fully revealed the theoretical issues, the answer contains significant errors. When performing practical tasks, the student makes significant errors, and the performance of the tasks causes significant difficulties for the student.

An unsatisfactory (FX) grade is given to a student who has not revealed the theoretical issues and cannot complete the practical tasks. As a rule, such a student shows the ability to express his thoughts only at an elementary level.

The grade of unsatisfactory (F) is given to a student who has not completed the curriculum or some element of its component, has fragmentary knowledge that does not allow him to reveal theoretical issues and complete practical tasks. Such a student cannot express his opinion even at an elementary level.

According to the results of the control of students' knowledge, it is allowed to give an examination grade (without a final exam) - "excellent", "good", and "satisfactory". The student has the right to increase the grade by taking the exam.
