



Criteria for evaluating modular tests

During the semester in which the discipline is studied, applicants perform two modular tests, each of which is evaluated in the range from 0 to 30 points.

Modular tests are performed in writing.

Criteria for evaluating final semester tests

Higher education applicants who have a final pre-examination rating score of at least 35 are allowed to take the exam. The final pre-examination rating score is determined as the arithmetic average of the final score for the 1st module and the final score for the 2nd module.

A higher education applicant whose pre-examination rating score is from 0 to 34 points is obliged to improve it before the start of the exam during the shift of teachers at the department within

the terms determined by the teacher of the discipline and agreed upon by the dean's office of the faculty. Otherwise, the applicant will not be allowed to take the exam and will incur academic debt.

A higher education applicant may not take an exam in an academic discipline if he/she has successfully passed all module tests and is satisfied with the final pre-examination rating score. Higher education applicants whose rating score is from 35 to 59 must take the exam. An education applicant may increase their rating score on the exam, however, based on the results of the exam, the score cannot be lower than the pre-examination rating score.

The exam is conducted orally. The educational material for both modules is submitted for the exam. The exam ticket consists of three theoretical questions. The evaluation of the results of the exam is carried out on a 100-point scale. The exam score is entered in the progress record
