**The aim of the program is** to train highly qualified, competitive specialists with broad employment opportunities in Ukraine and abroad, who have fundamental professional knowledge of international economic relations, possess modern economic thinking and applied skills necessary to solve problems and challenges in the field of international economic relations at various levels.

## 3 - Characteristics of the educational program

**Object of study:** functioning and development of international economic relations, methodologies and methods of their research, the interact of entities in the world economy in the process of evolution of International cooperation in the process of evolution of international cooperation.

**Learning objectives:** training of specialists capable of solving complex tasks and problems in the process of professional activity in the field of international economic relations, which involve research and/or innovation and are characterized by uncertainty of conditions and requirements.

**Theoretical content of the subject area:** economics of global economic relations , laws of its formation, the development of social reproductive processes in their interconnection and interdependence on the basis of international economic activity, international division of labor and institutional mechanism of regulation in the process of transformation of international economic relations and international economic cooperation.

**Methods, techniques and technologies:** methods of theoretical and empirical research, economic and mathematical analysis, modeling and forecasting, data analysis techniques, information retrieval and processing technologies, systematic data analysis, expert evaluation of the results of international economic relations.

**Tools and equipment** include modern universal and specialized information systems (information and communication, information search, information and analytical) and specialized software used in the activities of international economic relations entities.

Compulsory academic subjects - 75%, of which: general training subjects - 30%, professional training - 40%, practical training - 5%.

Subjects of the student's free choice are 25%, of which those that expand: GC - 7.5%, professional competencies - 17.5%.

35% of the volume of the educational program is allocated to ensure the general competencies in this specialty, defined by the higher education standard.

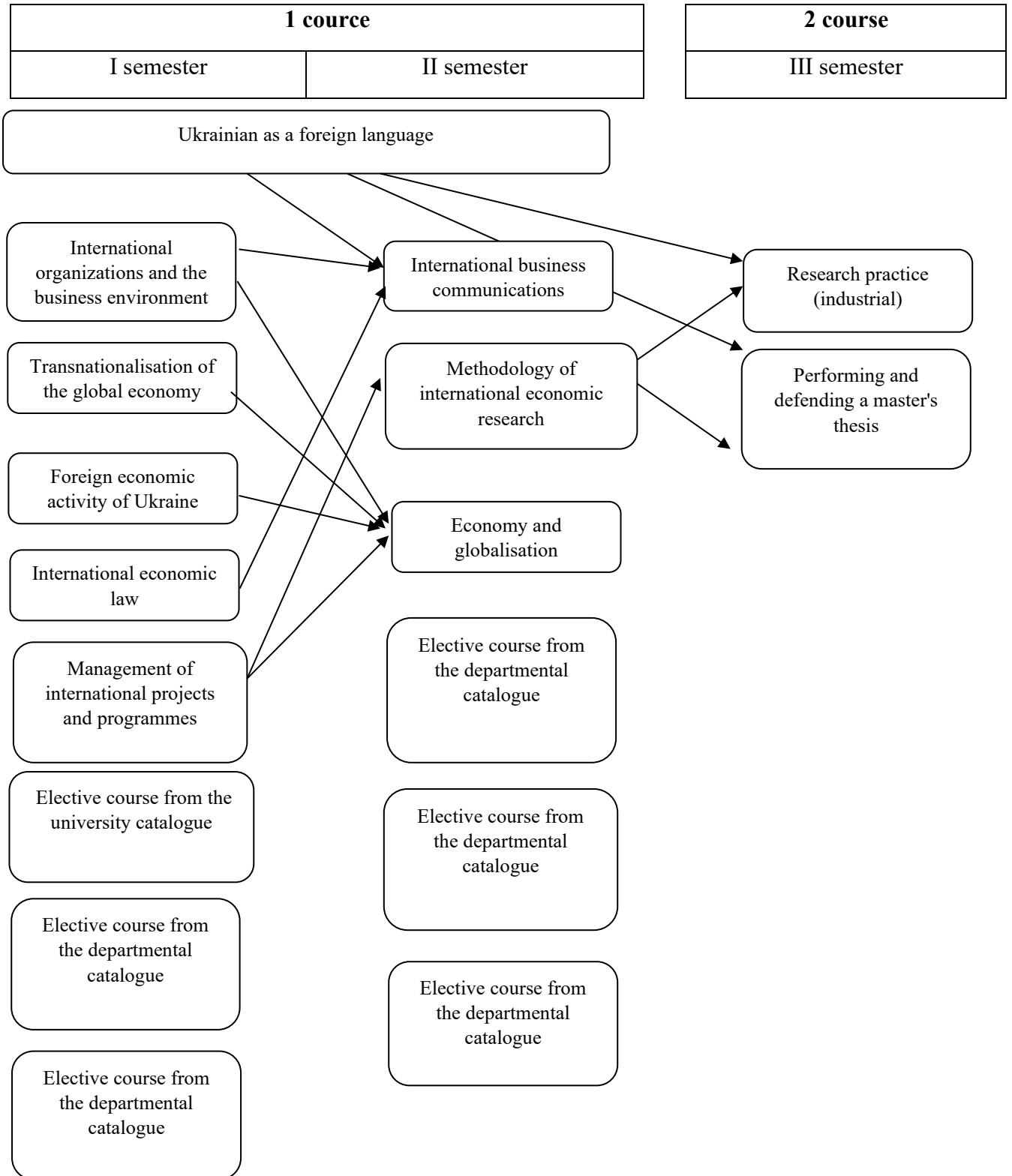

| <b>Requirements for qualification (master's) thesis</b>   | <p>The qualifying master's thesis must provide for the solution of a complex task or problem in the field of international economic relations, which requires research and/or innovation and is characterised by uncertainty of conditions and requirements.</p> <p>A qualifying master's thesis must not contain academic plagiarism, fabrication, or falsification.</p> <p>The qualifying master's thesis must be published on the official website of the University or its subdivision, or in the University repository.</p> <p>In the process of public defence, a higher education student must demonstrate the ability to clearly and confidently present the content of the research, answer questions and lead a discussion. The report must be accompanied by presentation materials and an explanatory note intended for public viewing.</p> <p>The decision of the examination committee to award the Master's degree in International Economic Relations and the issuance of a diploma based on the results of the final certification of students are announced after the minutes of the examination committee meetings are drawn up in accordance with the established procedure.</p> |
